## *Our Main Variety Of White Grapes*

### *Chardonnay*

A green-skinned grape variety believed to have originated in the Burgundy wine region of eastern France. Its aroma is distinct, yet delicate, difficult to characterize, easier to recognize the Chardonnay grape is itself very neutral, with many of the flavors commonly associated with the grape being derived from such influences as terrier and oak. Chardonnay matches very well with dishes that are served with a lot of butter or a cream.

### *Sauvignon blanc*

Originally originated from the Bordeaux region of France. The green-skinned grape gets its name from the French word 'sauvage' (wild) and 'blanc' (white). Depending on climate, the flavour can range from aggressively grassy to sweetly tropical. Wine experts have the phrase "crisp, elegant and fresh" as a favourable description for this grape variety.

### *Riesling*

Riesling is a white grape variety which originates in the Rhine region of Germany. Riesling is an aromatic grape variety displaying flowery, almost perfumed, aromas as well as high acidity. It is used to make dry, semi-sweet, sweet and sparkling white wines. Riesling wines are usually by variety pure and are seldom oaked.

### *Chenin blanc*

Chenin blanc or 'pineau de la Loire', is a variety of white wine grape from the Loire valley of France. Outside the Loire, it is found in most of the new world wine regions; it is the most widely planted variety in South Africa, where it is known as full-bodied fruity varietal palate.

## *Our Main Variety Of Red Grapes*

### *Merlot*

A grape that is used as both a blending grape and for varietal wine. Hence Merlot has become the darling red wine for most wine drinkers. Merlot-based wines usually have medium body with hints of berry, plum and currant. As a varietal wine, Merlot can make soft, velvety wines with plum flavors. The softness and 'fleshiness', combined with its earlier ripening makes Merlot an ideal grape to blend.

### *Cabernet sauvignon*

A hybrid offspring of Sauvignon Blanc and Cabernet Franc; it is one of the world's most widely recognized red wine grape varieties. The particularly thick skin of the grape results in wines that can be high in tannin making it the most dependable candidate for aging, more often improving into a truly great wine in body and structure than any other single varietal. In the mouth, Cabernet can have liveliness and even a degree of richness, yet usually finishes with firm astringency.

### *Shiraz*

Also known as Syrah. Shiraz is widely used to make full rich dry red table wine and are often quite powerfully flavoured and full-bodied. The berry is thick-skinned and dark, almost black. Aroma characters can range from violets to berries.

### *Pinotage*

A red wine grape that is South Africa's signature variety. It was bred there in 1952, a cross between Pinot Noir and Cinsaut. It typically produces deep red varietal wines with good depth of flavor, unique, fruity and refreshing. Its flavours vary from smoky, bramble and earthy, sometimes with notes of bananas and tropical fruit. There are also popular 'blush' versions and several fortified into port-style sweet dessert wines.

### *Rosé wine*

A **rose** (French: "rosé", pinkish colour) wine has some of the colour typical of a red wine, but only enough to turn pink. The pink colour can range from a pale orange, to a vivid near-purple, depending on the grapes and wine making techniques. The flavors of rosé wines tend to be more subtle versions of their red wine varietal counterparts. Rosés are perfect for spring and summer, and can bear refreshing accompaniment to a variety of warm weather fare. Rosé wines also top the charts for food-friendly versatility. So, if you are opting for "surf 'n turf" rest assured that a rosé can handle both the seafood and the steak in one fell sip.
